Hand tools may look harmless, but they are the cause of many injuries and we all need to make sure these remain safe.

Hammers, drills, wrenches, chisels, pliers, screwdrivers, and other hand tools are often underrated as sources of potential danger.

We will be looking at some simple steps to make sure our tools are ready to use and go back to work, just like us.



We will also cover the basics of some safety checks for electrical and battery operated tools.

It is important we always check equipment thoroughly before using it. Sound can be a very powerful tool (excuse the pun!). We can utilise it to tell if a power tool or piece of equipment is running properly. Listen for changes in the sound level, pitch or frequency.
