Lift-Off – How it may help

Grants may be used to help pay for:

- Short training courses which allow individuals to acquire new skills or upgrade/maintain existing skills
- Personal protective clothing or work clothing to allow the uptake of training/work
- Tools or necessary equipment to allow the uptake of training/work
- Travel costs to allow individuals to cover the initial cost involved in accepting a new job or work.

- Or be currently engaging with an East Dunbartonshire Council Employability Programme.
